Happy New Year to everyone. "Tis the Season to be Jolly" . . . a familiar refrain.




ica's West as seen through the Eyes of a German" and will be presented by **Barbara Taron**. Please join us for this presentation concerning a topic which should be of interest to all of us.



All in all it was a good year, a busy year, and I thank you for being a part of it. For 2003 I would like to wish you good health, good good friends.




