Die Deutsche Konversationsrunde

The regularly scheduled November Konversationsrunde will not be held as planned. This will allow members who wish to attend the annual Remembrance Day (Volkstrauertag) commemorating WWII German POWs in the SW USA who died during and after WWII while in American custody. The service will be held at the Ft. Reno Chapel (built by German POWs) at 2:00 PM on Sunday, November 13. The service will be conducted mostly in English, but with German prayers and songs as well. Ft Reno is located just north of Exit 119 on Interstate 40 west of El Reno. We have found this to be a moving experience which in the greater sense is a tribute to all the soldiers from every country who gave their lives during WWII.

The Konversationsrunde is a program under the auspices of the German-American Society of Tulsa Arts Association. It serves to promote the German language and other cultural interests of its members.
