#### ...FROM THE GAST PRESIDENT







### What in the heck is a Stammtisch anyway?

The word defines a special table in a Wirtschaft (a pub or restaurant), a table reserved for special customers, ie. regulars.

A Stamm is an expression for valued, well-known guests and customers who have an unusual loyalty to the place they frequent, be it because of other friends, good service, or the atmosphere. Thus, a Stammtisch is the cherished table, reserved for loyal, trusted, good guests. Stammgast is the person invited to sit at the Stammtisch. Stammkunde is the loyal customer who frequents a business. Stammplatz is the favored place a customer likes to sit at. Stamm is the trunk of a tree, but it is also based on the direct translation of the word applied to the old Germanic tribes or clans.

Although a Stammtisch gathering in the olden days implied: men only, it is nowadays generally open to women also. However, a lone woman at the Tisch might feel somewhat ignored since the topics being discussed would normally lean toward male interests.
