So much for Global Warming! In parts of the US and other parts of the world it has been one of the coldest winters since we started recording data on snowfall and temperatures. Mother Nature also

threw some curveballs for our various festivities and money-making efforts. Nevertheless the GAST boards kept meeting and planning and hoping for more benevolent weather for our next ventures.

Weather certainly did not keep German Language enthusiasts at home. For Kinderdeutsch seven eager students showed up and signed up on February 8th and the Adult Classes filled up almost to capacity with 68 students (at last count) on February 11th. Ruth Obermark had some tense times filling the teaching slots, but she managed to put another fabulous team together. The Adult Classes are being taught by Christopher Day, Doris Gallagher, Carol Masters, Grete McNac, Angela Novak, and Katie Sloan and Kinderdeutsch by Gracie Weiderhaft. To make sure the children get some physical exercise after their brains got a good work-out, Jeff Mosburg again volunteered to teach the students some German songs and dances.

The children certainly learned very fast to say 'bitte' and 'danke' when it came to enjoying juice and cookies served on Valentine napkins – after language class. Since I had no recollection of celebrating Valentine's Day when I grew up in Austria or Germany and only got acquainted with this special day once I came to the United States, I wondered where and when this tradition started. I'll tell you, there are about a dozen Valentinos honored as Saints by the Catholic Church going back to the third century CE. Going back further to pagan times Lupercalia—pastoral festivities—were held February 13 -15. But it is an English poet -Geoffrey Chaucer of 'The Canterbury Tales' fame - who is credited with inventing the holiday as it is celebrated today. About 1375 he wrote the poem 'Parliament of Fowles' in which he links courtly love with the celebration of St. Valentine's Feast Day February 14th on which 'birds and humans come together to find a mate'. While this day—set aside for love—was mostly celebrated in countries with English roots and traditions, global communication certainly changed that and Valentine cards and greetings now come from and are sent to all corners of the globe. Sharing the positive aspects of a culture and love in particular certainly should be maintained.

GASAA gets another chance to show and spread our German heritage and culture at the TCC Global Fest on February 25th. Arnold Bieber and Barbara Conrad are hard at work to put together another prize-winning exhibition. Ditto for 'Kids World' November 19-22 for which Jeff Mosburg has volunteered to accept the chairmanship.

Who of German background has not read or heard about Karl May? 

Prominent German composer of the late 19th and early 20th centuries, born in Siegburg, near Bonn, in 1854, and died of a heart attack at the age of 67 in Neustrelizt. He worked as a teacher and opera critic for various publications, and composed a number of operas based on fairy tales including Dornröschen (Sleeping Beauty), Hänsel und Gretel, and Die Königskinder (the Royal Children), as well a number of orchestral pieces.
