




When you put up your 2018 calendar, be sure to put a circle around that date.

Many of the Christmas traditions celebrated throughout the United States and other parts of the modern world today were brought here by German immigrants. The advent wreath, the Christmas tree, the baking of gingerbread cookies (Lebkuchen) and gingerbread houses were all customs common throughout central Europe since the middle ages. Early German settlers along the American East Coast

found plenty of fir or pine trees to chop down and decorate with apples, nuts and popcorn strings. Later, candles were added to be carefully lit to prevent starting a house fire. They were replaced in the late 19th century by safer strings of electric light bulbs.

Hand-blown glass ornaments got their start in Lauscha, a small town in Thuringia (Thüringen), Germany, in the early 19th century. And last but not least, there is the German Christkindlmarkt/Weihnachtsmarkt tradition which we have adopted as a fundraiser for our organization, taking place this year on the first weekend in December.



Each year, GAST imports many varieties of tree ornaments, nut crackers, calendars and specialty gift items for sale in the "Laden." Be sure to check it out. The "Bäckerei" offers the original German Advent calendars, Stollen, Lebku-

chen, Marzipan and chocolates for sophisticated tastes. Barbara Conrad's "Bethlehem Village" will be back this year.
