

Membership Chair Carol Wright found a new printing service which prints the ECHO in bright colors at a cost less than what we were paying for black on white. Some of you may have seen the last Adventsfeier program which was printed by the same service using a better paper quality at a lower cost.

This month the German American Society of Tulsa (GAST) will celebrate its 38th Anniversary at our annual Anniversary Party on Saturday, January 13th. Much has been accomplished during

those 38 years, not the least of which was the acquisition and renovation of the former Second Church of Christ Scientist building at 2301 East 15th Street in 1991. The multi-functional facility, now called the GAST Event Center, not only serves the needs of our membership, but it has also become a premier venue for wedding receptions and social gatherings. It is currently undergoing a major repair and face lift of the west entrance foyer.

The German American Society Arts Association (GASAA or ARTS) was organized in 1981, a year after GAST was incorporated. All members of GAST automatically become members of GASAA by joining the organization, at no additional cost. As a 501(C)(3) organization GASAA can accept donations for cultural and educational purposes that are tax-deductable to the donor.

In 2000 the German American Society Arts Association Endowment Trust was formed to assure the long-term availability of funds for maintenance and upkeep of the GAST Center and/or for cultural and educational pur-

poses. The Endowment Trust also received a 501(C)(3) designation by the Internal Revenue Service.

At the Anniversary Party we will honor the founding members and past presidents of GAST and GASAA and recognize those members who have contributed to the goals of the German American Society with outstanding accomplishments in 2017.

The German language Adventsfeier on Sunday, December 10th at 3 PM with retired pastor Inge Matern from Celle, our sister city in Germany, was attended by about 65 members and guests. The event was chaired by Barbara Conrad, who was also in charge of a very memorable Volkstrauertag service on November 19 at Fort Reno, Oklahoma.

I hope your New Year is filled with excitement and good health.

German Language Classes are set to begin on Tuesday, January 23rd. Classes are open to the public, so help us spread the word by telling your family and friends.

Classes for the 12-week session take place on Tuesday nights from 7 - 9PM at the GAST Center. No need to pre-register. Show up at 6:30 for class on January 23rd, bring your payment and we'll take care of the paperwork then. You'll be assigned to a class that matches your skill level – from "never ever" to advanced – and you will be provided with

books and materials. Classes cost \$80 for existing GAST members, \$100 for non-GAST members and books cost \$50. Cash, checks and credit cards are accepted.\*

The "never-evers" class is designed for people who have never experienced the German language and want to try it out. There are usually 20-30 students in this class," according to Ruth Obermark, GAST Language Class coordinator. "Other classes typically have 8-12 students."

"I am very proud of the team of teachers we have lined up," said Obermark. "All of our teachers have many years of experience teaching German in our local high schools and junior colleges and two of our teachers were born and raised in Germany. All have lived in Germany while they were learning the language."

GAST has been offering high quality/low-cost German language classes to the public since the early '80s.
