In Memoriam: Ken Renberg

Long time GAST member and supporter Kenneth "Ken" Renberg passed away on November 3 at the age of 97. Born Günter Renberg on November 30, 1920 in Delmenhorst, Germany, he immigrated to the United States in 1937. He enlisted in the Oklahoma National Guard 45th Division which was mobilized by President Franklin D. Roosevelt. After some training as an POW interrogator he took part in the invasion of Omaha Beech with the 1st Infantry Division.

After the war Ken settled in Tulsa, attended Tulsa University and became a successful petroleum engineer. He retired in 2011.
