

First proclaimed as an annual holiday by President Ronald Reagan on the 300th Anniversary of the date in 1683 when 13 German families from Krefeld landed in Philadelphia. These families subsequently founded Germantown, Pennsylvania, the first German settlement in the original thirteen American colonies.

German immigration continued through colonial times and increased during most of the 19th century due to religious and political persecution, wars and the lack of arable land to feed growing families in Germany. New waves of Germans arrived after WW1 and WW2.

German-American Day honors German-Americans who excelled in the fields of science, business, politics and arts.


