Rentals for our Event Center is very poor (almost non-existent). The Board decided to discontinue spending on advertising because we are not getting any meaningful results. We will continue our efforts to rent our facilities on referrals and without advertising.





The brewery was voted the best new brewery in the U.S. in 2016 by Rate Beer! Currently, they're experimenting with a "pop up kitchen" with a full menu, but not sure what will be available in April. Sounds interesting!

May 15th – Elgin Park Brewery (New Destination), 325 E Brady St, located near ONEOK field, is a brewery and a pizza joint. There are 6 house-brewed drafts to choose from as well as well as a selection of other local beers. Thin-crust pizza appears to be their specialty, so we won't leave hungry.

June 19th - Pearl Beach Brewpub, 418 S Peoria, is a beach volleyball bar with an onsite brewery and taproom. This should be a fun place to visit in the summer.
